

Black Walnut



Black walnut is a subangular media, but because of its low Moh hardness, it generally does not leave an anchor pattern. This makes the walnut shells ideal for cleaning dirt, grease, oil, carbon, scale, burrs and flaking paint on delicate surfaces. Other uses include the cleaning of auto body panels, electric motors, aircraft engines, dies, molds, polishing watches, jewelry and restoring antique surfaces.
